

Living in New York, British born, **Janine Menlove** is a photo-based artist. Through constructed photography and assemblage art, she explores relationships between object, place, and time. Using only her original photographs, Menlove creates narratives of personal and/or global reference in her characteristic style that blends significance and whimsy. Nature, humor, wit, and words are common elements found in her numerous projects of diverse themes and concepts—she is always pushing the boundaries of her creativity.

Menlove's diverse topics include "flower portraits" representing remarkable women in history, a series of still-life's that—through a personal lens—portray the universal message of the magic of books, concrete vs greenspace "fairy tales", and multiple projects featuring the awe-inspiring Hudson River.

Menlove's prolific career in commercial photography created opportunities and awareness in a myriad of subjects that inform her artwork today. Traveling the globe on thousands of assignments, photographing cars, places, architecture, and celebrities created an extensive archive of photographs central to her visual story telling.
